

PARENT PARTICIPATION REQUIRED for SACRAMENTS

Please be Prepared: *These dates will appear in the bulletin. If you have internet, please go to stmichaelmckinney.org for the most current information:*

1. All parents of Sacrament Students must attend the **Parent Classes (6-8 weeks) and show Certificate of Completion.**
2. No Sacrament without a copy of the **Baptismal Record.** If your child was Baptized at St. Michael's, give the Registrar the month and year at time of enrollment.

IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE:

- If your child is in the **first year of preparation for First Communion** (either second grade or first year of RCIC), you will need to attend the **Preparation for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.** Please watch your bulletin for this announcement.
- If your student is in the **second year of preparation for First Communion** (3rd grade, or second year of RCIC), you will be required to attend **Jesus Day with your child.** You will also be required to attend the **Parent meeting in Preparation for Holy Eucharist.** Please watch bulletin for dates.
- If your child is in **first year preparation for Confirmation** or 8th grade (or older in RCIC), you will need to attend the **Saints Workshop** with your child. Please watch for this meeting in the bulletin.
- If your child is in the **second year of preparation for Confirmation**, You will be required to be present for a **personal interview with your child** and sponsor if possible. This is by appointment. You will be able to choose days for this appointment. You will be given a folder of forms to fill out and return on the appointed day. The Sponsor will be required to fill out a form and present either a Marriage Certificate showing marriage in the church, or Confirmation Certificate if single. All release forms for travel must be filled out, as your child will be required to go on retreat (traditionally to East Texas.) All monies and paperwork will be required by **February 4, at the Retreat Orientation.** **This meeting is mandatory,** so please mark your calendars now. At least one parent will need to be present and the **child will not be in attendance** at this meeting.
